

TEACH is pleased to welcome WiscNet as an Internet Service Provider (ISP) option on the new BadgerNet network contract with AT&T. Because WiscNet has been added as an ISP, there are two BadgerNet contract options for Internet Service Providers on TEACH. The options are “AT&T MIS on BadgerNet” or “WiscNet on BadgerNet”.

If you indicated WiscNet as your ISP on the Excel sheets that were sent to you in October 2016 or in the Excel sheets that were sent in the last two weeks, WiscNet will be your ISP during transformation from BCN to BadgerNet. No further action on your part is necessary.

Your Internet Service Provider cost will be based on your student enrollment. The level of service is based on the amount of bandwidth you request from TEACH. For example, a 100 Mbps transport circuit from TEACH would mean you have up to 100 Mbps Internet service.

Customers ordering WiscNet on BadgerNet services must be WiscNet members. To find out about the membership fee go to <https://www.wiscnet.net>.

Pricing information is always available on our [Rate Sheet](#) located on our [BadgerNet](#) portal. Termination charges apply to TEACH customers for services that are not kept for 12 months from the installation date.
