FY18 Infrastructure Grants Awarded - \$7.85M between 252 grants (school districts only)

New Legislation allowing \$15M for infrastructure grants in FY18; portable hotspot now allowed as part of grant purchase

Fall 2017

Round 2 Infrastructure Grants Awarded - \$1.44 M between 88 grants

March 2017

Teacher training grants awarded - \$1.5 M for 27 consortiums comprised of 201 districts

The BadgerNet contract was signed, and will provide greater broadband capacity. The TEACH program will spend \$5M annually with 1GB of service, with an annual savings of \$700,000

Round 1 Infrastructure Grants Awarded -\$3.54M between 141 grants

25 Teacher Training grants awarded to public schools

June 2016

July 2016

TEACH paid BCN contracted rates for 1GB speeds, resulting in \$360,000 annual savings for schools and libraries



TEACH rate table change resulted in an annual savings of \$600,000 for schools and libraries


